Dear Resident,

A professional pest control technician will be at our complex on _____

Working together will maximize the effectiveness of this pest control program. Please follow these simple directions.

PLEASE DO:

- Clean up any spills. By removing alternative food sources, roaches are more likely to feed exclusively on the bait treatment.
- Store all food in airtight containers.
- Empty trash frequently.
- Rinse and store recyclable cans and bottles in airtight containers.
- Please remove any items from the top of the stove and refrigerator. We must move the appliances.
- Flush dead roaches and egg capsules down the toilet.

PLEASE DON'T

- Spray any insecticides on or near bait placements. It may prevent insects from eating the bait.
- Do not use strong cleaners on or near the baits.
- Do not store paper bags between your refrigerator and cabinets. Roaches harbor there.

It will NOT be necessary for you to empty all your cabinets and drawers before your appointment, however, for best results; we ask that all articles including canned goods, foodstuff and utensils from the kitchen and bathroom cupboards and drawers are removed.

“State law requires that you be given the following information:

CAUTION: PESTICIDES ARE TOXIC CHEMICALS. Structural Pest Control operations are licensed and regulated by the Structural Pest Control Board and apply to pesticides which are registered and approved for use by the California Department of Food and Agriculture and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. Registration is granted when the state finds that, based on existing scientific evidence, there are no appreciable risks if proper use conditions are followed or that the risks are outweighed by the benefits. The degree of risk depends upon the degree of exposure, so exposure should be minimized.

ANTICOAGULANT REACTION:

If Rodenticide ingestion occurs, you may experience symptoms of mild shock or bleeding.

PESTICIDE REACTION:

If within 24 hours following application you experience symptoms similar to common seasonal illnesses comparable to the flu: “Contact your physician or poison control center and your pest control operator immediately.”
