## PREPARATION INSTRUCTIONS

Dear Resident:

A professional Pest Control Technician will be at our complex on \_\_\_\_\_

### PEST PROBLEM

The following procedures must be complied with in order to service you, or you will forfeit this free service and be charged accordingly:

We require you to be out of the apartment/unit for a minimum of 3 hours after a spray treatment: Pets ie: cats, dogs, and birds should be removed from the unit treated as well. Fish tanks should be covered and the pump turned off during the treatment.

### REQUIREMENTS

#### **SERVICE FOR COCKROACHES:**

Remove all articles, canned goods, foodstuffs, and utensils from the kitchen and bathroom cupboards and drawers. Remove shelf paper if possible. Remove everything off of the counters and stove. Place these articles in the middle of the living room floor and cover them with a blanket or sheet. When you return do not wash the shelves. Install new shelf paper. Flush dead roaches and egg capsules down the toilet.

#### **SERVICE FOR FLEAS:**

Take all articles off the floor areas (closets included) and move the furniture away from the walls. Launder bedclothes after treatment. Vacuum floors before and after treatment and throw the vacuum bag away. Do not shampoo carpets for 30 days.

#### **SERVICE FOR STORED PRODUCT PESTS: (Weevils, Grain Moths, etc.):**

Remove all foodstuffs and articles from the infested cupboard area(s). Inspect all foodstuff packages, even those unopened (discard all infested products into outside trash areas). Place infested foodstuffs and articles in the middle of the living room floor and cover them with a blanket or sheet. When you return do not wash the shelves off.

#### **SERVICE FOR ANTS AND SPIDERS:**

Empty any cabinets, closets or drawers that are to be treated. Also, clear any articles away from the baseboards.

The chemicals are a direct contact material, which means that the pest has to make contact and then slowly dies. The material will be effective for 30-60 days, which will also affect any eggs that may hatch during that time to arrest further re-occurrence.

Please notify the manager if you are unable to meet these specific requirements at least one day prior to your appointment. If you have any questions, please contact your community manager.

“State law requires that you be given the following information:

**CAUTION: PESTICIDES ARE TOXIC CHEMICALS.** Structural Pest Control operations are licensed and regulated by the Structural Pest Control Board and apply to pesticides which are registered and approved for use by the California Department of Food and Agriculture and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. Registration is granted when the state finds that, based on existing scientific evidence, there are no appreciable risks if proper use conditions are followed or that the risks are outweighed by the benefits. The degree of risk depends upon the degree of exposure, so exposure should be minimized.

**ANTICOAGULANT REACTION:**

If Rodenticide ingestion occurs, you may experience symptoms of mild shock or bleeding.

**PESTICIDE REACTION:**

If within 24 hours following application you experience symptoms similar to common seasonal illnesses comparable to the flu: “Contact your physician or poison control center and your pest control operator immediately.”
