PREPARATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR RODENT TREATMENTS

Dear Resident:

The following procedures must be complied with in order to service you or you will forfeit the free services and be charged accordingly. If we are called out to a unit on an emergency or for a last minute pest control service and we are turned away because the tenant is not prepared to treat the unit or the problem was resolved before our arrival, we will be forced to charge a \$40 fuel-surcharge beginning immediately.

REQUIREMENTS

SERVICE FOR RATS AND MICE:

Remove all food off of the counters and stove. Place these articles in air tight containers or in the refrigerator. It is imperative you keep areas as clean as possible and without other food sources available to the rodents so they will have no other alternative other than to feed from the bait provided. Empty the trash into an outside dumpster each night. If any exclusion work is recommended have it taken care of immediately.

The chemicals are a direct contact material and it will be effective for 30-60 days.

Please notify the manager if you are unable to meet these specific requirements at least one day before the appointment. If you have any questions please contact your community manager.

“State law requires that you be given the following information:

CAUTION: PESTICIDES ARE TOXIC CHEMICALS. Structural Pest Control operations are licensed and regulated by the Structural Pest Control Board and apply to pesticides which are registered and approved for use by the California Department of Food and Agriculture and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. Registration is granted when the state finds that, based on existing scientific evidence, there are no appreciable risks if proper use conditions are followed or that the risks are outweighed by the benefits. The degree of risk depends upon the degree of exposure, so exposure should be minimized.

ANTICOAGULANT REACTION:

If Rodenticide ingestion occurs, you may experience symptoms of mild shock or bleeding.

PESTICIDE REACTION:

If within 24 hours following application you experience symptoms similar to common seasonal illnesses comparable to the flu: “Contact your physician or poison control center and your pest control operator immediately.”
