THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURES MUST BE COMPLIED WITH IN ORDER TO SERVICE YOU OR YOU WILL FORFEIT THIS SERVICE AND BE CHARGED ACCORDINGLY.

PREPARATION REQUIREMENTS:

We may require you to be out of the apartment/unit during or after a treatment. Pets i.e.: cats, dogs, and birds should be removed from the unit treated as well. It is not necessary for you to empty all your cabinets and drawers before your appointment, however, we suggest, for best results, that all articles including canned goods, foodstuff and utensils from the kitchen and bathroom cupboards and drawers are removed. You are also required to complete the following preparations:

- Eliminate cockroach food sources by cleaning all counter tops, floors, and other surfaces. Wash dishes and take out garbage daily. This will also improve bait acceptance by the cockroaches.
- Store all food in airtight containers.
- Declutter your kitchen and bathroom(s) to limit harborage areas.
- Rinse and store recyclable cans and bottles in airtight containers.
- Please remove any items from the top of stove and refrigerator. We will move the appliances.
- · Flush dead roaches and egg capsules down the toilet.
- DO NOT store paper bags between your refrigerator and cabinets. Roaches harbor there.
- DO NOT use strong cleaners on or near the baits.
- DO NOT self-treat. This can cause the cockroaches to spread and can counteract our professional treatments.

Please notify the manager if you are unable to meet these specific requirements at least one day prior to your appointment. If you have any questions, please contact your community manager.

THANK YOU FOR YOUR COOPERATION

State law requires that you be given the following information:

CAUTION: PESTICIDES ARE TOXIC CHEMICALS. Structural Pest Control operations are licensed and regulated by the Structural Pest Control Board and apply to pesticides which are registered and approved for by use by the California Department of Food and Agriculture and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. Registration is granted when the state finds that, based on existing scientific evidence, there are no appreciable risks if proper use conditions are followed or that the risks are outweighed by the benefits. The degree of risk depends upon the degree of exposure, so exposure should be minimized.

ANTICOAGULANT REACTION:

If Rodenticide ingestion occurs, you may experience symptoms of mild shock or bleeding.

PESTICIDE REACTION:

If within 24 hours following application you experience symptoms similar to common seasonal illnesses comparable to the flu, contact your physician or poison control center and your pest control operator immediately.
