PREPARATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR AN INTERIOR GERMAN COCKROACH SPRAY

Dear Resident,

A professional Pest Control Technician will be at our complex on _____ between the hours of _____ AM/PM and _____ AM/PM.

THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURES MUST BE COMPLIED WITH IN ORDER TO SERVICE YOU OR YOU WILL FORFEIT THIS SERVICE AND BE CHARGED ACCORDINGLY.

PREPARATION REQUIREMENTS:

We require you to be out of the apartment/unit for a minimum of 3 hours after a spray treatment in order to allow the treatment to dry. Pets i.e.: cats, dogs, and birds should be removed from the unit treated as well. Fish tanks should be covered and the pump turned off during the treatment. You are also required to complete the following preparations:

- Remove all food and articles from cabinets and drawers.
- Eliminate cockroach food sources by cleaning all counter tops, floors, and other surfaces. Wash dishes and take out garbage daily.
- Rinse and store recyclable cans and bottles in airtight containers.
- Declutter your kitchen and bathroom(s) to limit harborage areas.
- Please remove any items from the top of stove and refrigerator. We will move the appliances.
- Inspect all foodstuff packages for cockroach activity. Place all infested food items in plastic garbage bags. and discard all infested products into outside trash bins.
- Place non-infested foodstuffs and articles in the middle of the living room floor and cover them with a blanket or sheet.
- When you return do not wash the shelves off.
- Flush dead roaches and egg capsules down the toilet.
- DO NOT store paper bags between your refrigerator and cabinets. Roaches harbor there.
- DO NOT use strong cleaners on or near the baits.
- DO NOT self-treat. This can cause the cockroaches to spread and can counteract our professional treatments.
- Be aware of where you shop for food. Cockroaches can be brought in from grocery stores.

The chemicals are a direct contact material, which means that the pest has to make contact and then slowly dies. Cracks and crevices in the infested areas will be treated to control eggs, adults, and nymphs. Cockroach baits and Insect Growth Regulators (IGR) will be used. The material will be effective for 30-60 days, which will also affect further re-occurrence.

Please notify the manager if you are unable to meet these specific requirements at least one day prior to your appointment. If you have any questions, please contact your community manager.

State law requires that you be given the following information:

CAUTION: PESTICIDES ARE TOXIC CHEMICALS. Structural Pest Control operations are licensed and regulated by the Structural Pest Control Board and apply to pesticides which are registered and approved for by use by the California Department of Food and Agriculture and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. Registration is granted when the state finds that, based on existing scientific evidence, there are no appreciable risks if proper use conditions are followed or that the risks are outweighed by the benefits. The degree of risk depends upon the degree of exposure, so exposure should be minimized.

ANTICOAGULANT REACTION:

If Rodenticide ingestion occurs, you may experience symptoms of mild shock or bleeding.

PESTICIDE REACTION:

If within 24 hours following application you experience symptoms similar to common seasonal illnesses comparable to the flu, contact your physician or poison control center and your pest control operator immediately.
